Through St. Luke's Endowment Fund, grants are made to organizations near and far that support our brothers and sisters in Christ. Each week we highlight one of the grant recipients. RefugeeOne, an aid organization with a long history of shared ministry with St. Luke's, received a grant to support the emerging needs of Afghan humanitarian refugees. Of the 800 refugees that the organization will help in 2022, half are Afghans who fled the country after the Taliban seized control. Your support of the Endowment Fund helps provide housing, job training and counseling to these refuge seekers.

Through St. Luke's Endowment Fund, grants are made to organizations near and far that support our brothers and sisters in Christ. Each week we highlight one of the grant recipients. The Center of Concern uses its grant to provide housing solutions, support services and counseling for older adults, people with disabilities and others in need to enable them to live with dignity and independence. Several members of our congregation volunteer at this local organization as well.

Father's Arms Ministries in Chicago received a grant to support its Community Outreach Program that provides bi-weekly food pantries, emergency food services, one-on-one counseling sessions and various other street ministries to help its neighbors in the midst of gang activity, violence and drug use. It also helps neighborhood residents through an after-school program for kids and job training and development programs for adults.

Of the families served by Concordia Place, 67% either received public support or were low-wage earners, making them eligible for the sliding tuition scale.

One leg is the Guardian Angel Program that accompanies migrant children and families as a physical presence of the church in the courtroom during hearings.
